B.S in Physiotherapy

Since 2018, the Higher Education Ordinance mandates a new degree requirement that encompasses comprehensive educational objectives relating to the understanding of men's violence against women and intimate partner violence. These objectives have been further specified and tailored to various educational programs at Swedish universities, highlighting specific competencies, skills, judgments, approaches and formulated content. Below are objectives in the Physiotherapy program from different universities.

Objectives

Knowledge and understanding

- Violence in close relationships in relation to disability.
- Describe basic facts about men's violence against women and violence in close relationships, as well as the importance of conversation in identifying violence.
- Account for the prevalence and consequences of men's violence against women and violence in close relationships in Sweden.
- Understand the different definitions of violence and the potential consequences for the affected individual.
- Identify and provide examples of how children are affected by and relate to men's violence against women.

Competence and skills

- Demonstrate insight into women's and children's vulnerability in close relationships with violence.
- Demonstrate insight into a professional approach in the field of violence exposure.
